## **1. Preamble**

The International Sport Amateur Games BELT AND ROAD PARTNER COUNTRIES AMATEUR GAMES BRWAG 2019 WENZHOU CHINA, 10/13 - 10/19 2019 are held in order to develop a mass sports exchange between the countries of "One Belt - One Road". The Competitions are based on the principles of Olympism, enshrined in the World Charter of Amateur Sport: strengthening peace and friendship among nations, strengthening interethnic cultural ties, demonstrating sporting achievements for non-commercial purposes, in order to promote a healthy lifestyle, to promote sports among the people, well-being, longevity and peace.

The format of the Games is defined as international competitions in various sports among amateurs within a single event combining sports and cultural events.

## **2. Management**

The overall management of the Games is carried out by the Organizing Committee of the Games (OCG), which is composed of representatives of the Organizers of the Games. The direct management of competitions in sports is carried out by international and national sports federations and organizations that are part of the OCG.

The competence of the OCG includes:

- Approval of the regulations of competitions in sports;
- Management of competitions in sports;
- Approval of the conditions and rules for participation in the Games of amateur athletes;
- Compilation and execution of the program of the Games and the schedule of competitions, as well as other events of the Games, including the cultural program of the Games, including the Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the Games;
- Provision, including technical, of sports facilities where competitions are held;
- Ensuring refereeing, including arbitration;
- Ensuring the stay of participants and guests of the Games, including their accreditation, resettlement, transport and food, during the Games;
- Information support of the Games and participants of the Games;
- The provision of award-winning competitors;
- Providing emergency medical care for participants of the Games;
- Ensuring the safety of all events of the Games.

## **3. Sports**

- Football - Futsal: 5x5, 4x4, 3x3 (football in the hall);
- Tennis;
- Swimming (swimming pool);
- Beach sports (beach volleyball and beach tennis);
- Table tennis.

Sports can be supplemented or reduced by the decision of the Organizing Committee of the Games.

#### **4. Participants**

Participants in the Games can be all amateur athletes who have registered for the competition. The procedure for registration and accreditation is established by OCG. Occupational and age limits can be set by the Regulations for each sport.

#### **5. Registration**

Every amateur athlete who participates in the Games must be pre-registered on the official Games website: [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

The competitor will be registered if he accepts the following mandatory conditions:

- Fill out a form with the name, surname, year of birth, country of residence, age, gender, contact details (email address);
- to confirm that he/she has a valid health insurance;
- to undertake an obligation of personal responsibility for their health;
- to purchase at their own expense a Package of Stay, including accommodation in the proposed hotels, local transfers to the venues of the competition, food, the right to participate in the events of the Games;
- to pay a registration fee of \$ 120;
- to come independently at their own expense to the Games;
- to confirm the agreement with this Regulation on the Games.

Registration deadlines are set by:

- beginning of registration: June 15, 2019.
- end of registration: September 15, 2019.

#### **6. Accreditation**

All registered competitors must undergo an accreditation procedure upon arrival at the Games from 13.10.2019 to 14.10.2019 in Wenzhou. The place of accreditation OCG establishes and announces no later than 1 month before the start of the competition and personally notifies all registered participants about it.

On the accreditation procedure, each participant must confirm their identity on the basis of personal documents (passport or other identity documents), provide the original medical insurance policy and sign an agreement on waiver of claims (acceptance of personal responsibility for their health during the Games).

Each accredited competitor receives a personal badge with a personal photo, indicating their first and last name, country of residence, souvenirs and a guide to Wenzhou. A participant who has not passed accreditation is not allowed to the competitions and events of the Games.

#### **7. Registration fee**

The OCG establishes a single registration fee in the amount of \$ 120, allowing each participant to apply for no more than 3 competitions in various sports, including for

disciplines in each sport in the amount established by the Competition Regulations for each sport.

Payment of the registration fee is made during the registration of the participant on the website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org) and is mandatory to complete the registration procedure.

For a participant who has paid the registration fee, but has not arrived at the competition or has not arrived for accreditation, or has withdrawn from the competition during the Games for any reason, the registration fee is not refundable.

## **8. Stay Packages at the Games**

The General Provisions establish that only those participants who have paid for the Stay Package at the Games provided by OCG are allowed to compete in the Games. Confirmation of registration for the Games, each participant will receive only after the payment of the registration fee and payment of the Stay Package. The order of the cost, choice and method of payment for the Stay Package is established by the OCG and published on the official Games website [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org). The Stay Package is paid before the start of the competition no later than the end of the Registration Period.

Stay Package includes:

- resettlement of participants of the Games in hotels of Wenzhou from 13.10.2019 to 20.10.2019 - 8 days 7 nights;
- food: breakfast in hotels, hot lunch at the competition venues, dinner in hotels;
- transport services: meeting of participants at Wenzhou airport on 10/13/2019 and (group transfer by buses) to the place of residence, farewell to participants from places of residence (group transfer by buses) to the airport of Wenzhou on 10.20.2019, daily during the competition period group transfer in the morning before the start of the competition from the hotel to their venue and in the evening after the end of the competition from their venue to the hotel, group transfer to the cultural events of the Games;
- participation in the Opening Ceremony of the Games, including the official speeches of the leaders of the Province, the City, the Organizing Committee of the Games, representatives of the Games participants, a gala dinner and performances by the artists;
- participation in the closing ceremony of the Games, including the awarding of the winners and prize-winners of the Games;
- an excursion to the sights of Wenzhou and its environs during one day during the competition, the provision of buses, guides in Russian and English, catering during the excursion.

The guests of the Games, who are the accompanying persons of the participants of the competition, acquire the Stay Packages on the same conditions as the participants of the competition.

Stay Packages are provided only for the period from 10/13/2019 to 10/20/2019. Participants and guests arriving earlier than the deadline, or departing later than the deadline, may receive an extension of their stay for an additional fee. In the event of a reduction in the length of stay of participants and guests at the Games, the cost of the Stay Package is non-refundable. In case of refusal to go to the Games, OCG has the right to withhold a penalty of at least 50% of the cost of the Stay Package, if the refusal was declared no later than 2 months before the start of the competition, and not less

than 100% if the refusal was announced later than 1 one month before the start of the competition.

Transfer of rights to a third party in the Stay Package is provided by prior agreement with OCG.

## 9. Terms of competitions in sports

**A. Football / Futsal.** Futsal and Micro futsal competitions are held among men's and women's teams without age restrictions. The venue for the Futsal competition is an indoor hall with parquet flooring (2 fields with parquet flooring with stands) at the Olympic Sports Center in Wenzhou. Competitions are held according to the Rules of the Futsal Games FIFUSA edition 2018. Regulations and competition management is determined and implemented by the International Federation of Futsal and Micro futsal FIFUSA. Rules, regulations, schedule, results of the competition are published on the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

**B. Tennis.** Tennis competitions are held among men and women in the individual competition with age restrictions, as well as among teams with age restrictions. The venue for the competition in Tennis is the International Tennis Center (11 courts with hard coating) in Wenzhou. Competitions are held according to the ITF Rules. The regulations and management of the competitions are determined and implemented by the Commission for Amateur Tennis FTR. Rules, regulations, schedule, results of the competition are published on the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

**C. Swimming.** Swimming competitions are held among men and women in the individual competition with age restrictions, as well as among teams (relay race) with age restrictions. The swimming competition is located in a 50m indoor pool (8 lanes) at the Olympic Sports Center in Wenzhou. Competitions are held according to the FINA Masters Rules. The regulations and competition management are determined and implemented by the Wenzhou City Sports Administration. Rules, regulations, schedule, results of the competition are published on the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

**D. Table Tennis.** Table Tennis competitions are held among men and women in the individual competition with age restrictions, as well as among teams with age restrictions. The venue for the Table Tennis competition is a universal gym (20 tables) at the Olympic Sports Center in Wenzhou. Competitions are held according to the rules of the ITTF. The regulations and competition management are determined and implemented by the Wenzhou City Sports Administration. Rules, regulations, schedule, results of the competition are published on the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

**E. Beach sports.** Competitions in Beach Sports: beach volleyball and beach tennis are held among men and women in the individual competition with age restrictions, as well as among teams with age restrictions. The venue for the Beach Sports competition is a beach with sandy courts in the bay of Dangtu district in Wenzhou. Competitions are held according to the FIVB (Beach Volleyball) and ITF (Beach Tennis) Rules. Regulations and competition management are determined and implemented by the Beach Sports Association Sportbeach. Rules, regulations, schedule, results of the competition are published on the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

By this Regulation, the registration fee for participation in all types of competitions is set at \$ 120.

Restrictions on the participation of one athlete in a certain number of disciplines in his chosen sport according to the approved Regulations of this sport are allowed.

Participation of one athlete in no more than 3 sports is allowed.

## **10. Judging**

The judging of the Games is carried out by the judges OCG. The number and composition of judges, as well as the procedure for submitting and considering complaints and appeals, is determined by the Competition Regulations for each sport. The highest court of the Games is the panel of judges and the Appeals Commission of the OCG.

## **11. Information support**

OCG provides the following information:

- during the registration period prior to the start of the Games for the participants of the competition: the program of games and events, a preliminary schedule of competitions in sports, the cost and procedure for purchasing packages for staying at the Games; information source - the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org);

- during the registration before the Games, during the Games and after the Games for advertising the event: preparing and distributing information about the Games and their results on the websites of the competition partners and other media, presentations, electronic mailings and social networks;

- during the Games for participants of the competition: the program of games and events, the daily schedule of competitions and events; information source - the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org), information board at the headquarters of the OCG in Wenzhou, printed notice boards at the venue for competitions in sports in Wenzhou;

- during the Games for spectators, guests, sponsors and advertisers: daily news release and live broadcasts on the course of competitions and events; information source - the official website of the Games [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org), the websites of the partners of the Games, the news television and radio channels of Wenzhou City, other media.

The official source of information for the Games is [icasworld.org](http://icasworld.org).

## **12. Ceremonies and Cultural Program**

The OCG organizes and conducts the Opening Ceremony for the Games. Date of the Ceremony: October 14, 2019, the time and place of the Ceremony, as well as the program of the Ceremony itself, is established by the Games Program, which the OCG publishes in its official sources and distributes to the registered participants and partners of the Games no later than 1 month prior to the Games.

The OCG organizes and conducts the Games Closing Ceremony, which includes the procedure for awarding participants to the Games. The date, time and place of the

Ceremony, as well as the program of the Ceremony itself, is established by the Games Program, which the OCG publishes in its official sources and distributes to the registered participants and partners of the Games no later than 1 month prior to the start of the Games.

The OCG organizes and conducts cultural events, including a free one-day bus tour for participants on the sights of Wenzhou. The date, time and place of cultural events, as well as a full list of events, is established by the Games Program, which the OCG publishes in its official sources and distributes to the registered participants and partners of the Games no later than 1 month before the start of the Games.

### **13. Preliminary schedule of the Games**

**10/13/2019** - Start of the check-in and continuation of the accreditation of participants and guests of the Games. Accreditation starts at 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Olympic Sports Center of Wenzhou city.

**10/14/2019** - Continuation of check-in and accreditation of participants and guests of the Games.

9:00 – 17:00 - football (futsal) Olympic Sports Center.

19:00 - 21:00 - Solemn Opening Ceremony of the Games.

10/15/2019 - Start of all sports competitions.

9:00 - 17:00 - football (futsal) Olympic Sports Center.

9:00 - 17:00 - tennis, International Tennis Center.

9:00 – 17:00 – table tennis, Olympic Sports Center.

9:00 - 17:00 - swimming, Olympic Sports Center.

9:00 - 17:00 - beach volleyball and beach tennis, the bay of Dangtu.

**10/16/2019** - Continuation of the competition according to the established schedule.

**10/17/2019** - Continuation of the competition according to the established schedule.

**10/18/2019** – The free day (but futsal) for Excursion – Bus Tour.

9:00 - 17:00 - football (futsal) Olympic Sports Center.

9:00 - 21:00 - morning: bus excursion to the countryside “Yongjia Nanxi River Scenic”; evening: bus and walking tour of the city of Wenzhou: the ancient shopping streets of Wuma, Nantang, other points of the tour program.

**10/19/2019** - Continuation of the competition according to the established schedule.

19: 00-21: 00 - Solemn Closing Ceremony of the Games. Awarding the winners of the competition. Olympic Sports Center.

**10/20/2019** – Check-out.

#### **14. Awards**

The OCG provides awards in the form of commemorative medals with the symbols of the Games to the winners of competitions in all sports and all disciplines included in the list of each sport of the Games according to the Regulations. Medals are awarded to participants in the individual and team competition, who took 1, 2, 3 places.

#### **15. Security**

OCG is responsible for ensuring technical safety at the sports facilities of the Games during the competition.

The administration of the city of Wenzhou is responsible for ensuring public safety at the sports facilities of the Games during the competitions and at the events of the games.

#### **16. Medical assistance**

The OCG is responsible for providing first aid to competitors at sports facilities during the Games. The first medical aid is provided by the staff medical staff of sports facilities.

Responsibility for providing emergency / emergency medical care to participants during competitions at sports facilities is borne by the administrative authorities of Wenzhou City.

Responsibility for injuries, accidents, illnesses that are not related to the technical safety of sports facilities during the competition, as well as in all circumstances outside the sports facilities during the competition, is borne by the participants themselves.

#### **17. Financing**

Financing of the Games is carried out at the expense of funds provided by OCG, advertising revenue, receipt of sponsorship funds, registration fees of the participants of the Games.

#### **18. Advertising and sponsorship**

OCG has the right to attract sponsors and enter into advertising contracts that allow placing information about sponsors and their products or services at the venues of the Games, as well as in any other information materials related to the Games.

#### **19. Final provisions**

The OCG is responsible to the parties hosting the Games - the Games Organizers, and the participants of the Games within the limits of their competence represented by these Regulations.

The OCG is guided in the performance of its duties with the accepted norms and rules for holding international sports competitions and the laws of the People's Republic of China.

The OCG has the right to make changes and additions to this General Provisions, subject to the mandatory condition of promptly informing all interested parties, first of all the participants of the competition, about such changes.
