REGULATIONS



GENERAL PROVISIONS.

1. Name

The name of the Competition: BELT AND ROAD PARTNER COUNTRIES AMATEUR GAMES BRWAG 2019, WENZHOU, CHINA. FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT - FUTSAL / MICROFUTSAL.

2. Location and dates

The venue of the Tournament is Wenzhou International Tennis Center, China, Olympic Sports Center. Address: 20 Minhang Rd, Lucheng Qu, Wenzhou Shi, Zhejiang Sheng, China, 325027, 浙江省温州市鹿城区民航路20号 邮政编码: 325027.

2 halls: the main hall with stands for futsal and microfutsal with stands for spectators 5,000 people and an electronic scoreboard, the second hall without stands for spectators, equipped with technical means for recording and displaying the score and playing time.

Start of the Tournament: May 13, 2019, End of the Tournament: October 19, 2019.

3. Registration and Accreditation

Registration for the Tournament is carried out in accordance with the BRWAG 2019 General Provisions of the Games online on the official Games website icasworld.org/registration.

Registration start: June 15, 2019

Registration Completion: September 15, 2019

Registration procedure: registration of football teams for the Games is carried out by a single list submitted by the International Federation of Futsal and Micro-Futsal FIFUSA to the Organizing Committee of the Games no later than June 20, 2019. Additions and changes in the single list are allowed no later than August 20, 2019.

Each football team should be described in a single list: the name of the team, the country the team represents, the list of team members, including players, coaches, doctors, referees and other team members. The personal data of each team member must be specified: name and surname, gender, age, country of residence, email address.

Accreditation: a mandatory procedure for each team member according to the Regulations on the Games. Accreditation is held from 12 to 13 October 2019. Accreditation Time: 9 : 00 - 17:00

For accreditation, every team member must have with him/her: an identity document (passport or other identity documents), a photo of 3x4 cm, the original medical insurance policy.

4. Admission to participation

Players are allowed to compete at least 18 years old. Age is determined at the time of December 31 of the current year.

Each team must pay a single team fee, which includes a package of stay in Wenzhou for the duration of the competition. The amount of the fee is set according to the cost of the selected package to stay. Only teams that have paid a fee of 100% at the time before the end of the registration period are allowed to compete.

Each team must be accredited by the FIFUSA International Futsal and Mikrofutsal Federation before registering for the Games. To receive accreditation, captains or team representatives must send a request to the representative of the Federation at brwag2019@icasworld.org to receive confirmation and inclusion in the list for registration at the Games.

5. Format

Teams representing countries participating in the Games take part in competitions of the Games.

Participation of club teams in the Micro-futsal tournament is possible.

5.1. Futsal competitions: held according to the Futsal Rules.

5.2. Competitions on Microfutsal: held according to the Rules on Microfutsal.

RULES OF COMPETITIONS

6. GAME RULES AND DISCIPLINARY CODE

The tournament is held in accordance with the current Rules of the game and the FIFUSA Disciplinary Code. Before the start of the gaming day, meetings are held with representatives of the teams and the judges of the tournament. Official ball tournament: "Barry".

7. COMPETITION SYSTEM

Competitions are held according to the calendar of competitions.

The teams participating in the tournament are divided into groups. Games in groups are held in a circular system. Two semi-finals and final.

If there are more than eight teams participating, it is allowed to hold the $\frac{1}{4}$ final.

With the participation of 5 or less teams, the games are held in one round.

Teams are guaranteed to play at least three games.

Teams can play friendly matches.

8. Qualification phase - groups

Games in groups are held in a circular system. Win - 3 points, defeat 0 points. With a draw result, 6-meter shots make their way into main time; the winner gets 2 points, the losing team - 1 point.

2.2. Distribution of teams in case of equality of points.

In case of equality of points for two or more teams in qualifying games, the places are distributed as follows:

a) by the result of the games between themselves (the number of points, the difference of matches, the highest number of goals scored);

b) by the highest number of matches won in all group tournament games;

c) by the best difference between goals scored and goals conceded in all group tournament games;

d) by the highest number of goals scored in all group tournament games;

d) by lot.

8.3. Games $\frac{1}{4}$ finals, $\frac{1}{2}$ finals and finals are held on a system of "playoffs". With a draw, the teams play an extra time of 2 times, 5 minutes each. With a draw in extra time, 6-meter shots are punched according to the Rules of the Game.

8.4. The player who received during the game 5 technical fouls, is removed from the site until the end of the game with the right to substitute. In the next game this player can take part.

8.5. A player who receives two yellow cards during one game is removed from the field and misses one next game.

8.6. The player who received the red card is removed to the end of the match and misses the next game. Further, according to the sanctions imposed by the FIFUSA Committee or the FIFUSA Commission (consisting of 3 persons).

8.7. If one of the teams fails to appear, penalties are applied in accordance with the FIFUSA Disciplinary Code, and the technical loss is counted for the team with a score of 0: 5.

9. CONDITIONS OF ORGANIZATION AND PARTICIPATION IN TOURNAMENT

9.1. The official delegation consists of a maximum of 18 people (12/14 players + 4/2 representatives of the team's coaching staff, 1 medic (doctor, paramedic or nurse) and 1 arbiter. Players cannot be replaced by managers or other accompanying persons.

9.2. The nomination of an arbitrator must be approved by the FIFUSA Judges Committee. The arbitrator is a member of the delegation and is accepted on general terms.

9.3. All members of the delegation must have with them documents proving their identity.

9.4. All members of the delegation must have sports medical insurance. Team players must have access to a doctor's games.

9.5. Each delegation gets to the venue of the competition independently and at its own expense.

9.6. Teams must make the following payments three months before the start of the competition:

- Participation fee of 500 Euro - at FIFUSA;

- Payment of accommodation package - to the Organizing Committee of the competition.

9.7. Players who are not settled in the hotel provided by FIFUSA are not allowed to participate in competitions. Players who leave the hotel ahead of time are also not allowed to participate in competitions.

9.8. Drinking alcohol, damage to property, indecent behavior on the territory of the sports complex - a fine of 200 Euros is imposed on the team.

10. SCHEMES OF HOLDING COMPETITIONS (STAGES)

10.1. . WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF UP TO 5 TEAMS, THE GAMES ARE HELD IN ONE ROUND.

10.2. . 6-8 TEAMS ARE DIVIDED INTO GROUPS OF 3-4 TEAMS;

- GAMES IN GROUPS;

- SEMIFINALS 1A-2B; 1B-2A;

- THE FINAL.

10.3. 9-11 TEAMS: - GAMES IN GROUPS;

IN $\frac{1}{4}$ FINAL COME OUT:

WITH 9 TEAMS 1-6 TEAMS, AND FROM 7-9 TEAMS (TEAMS THAT TOOK THIRD PLACES IN THEIR GROUPS) THERE ARE TWO TEAMS WITH THE BEST PERFORMANCE.

WITH 10 TEAMS 1-7 TEAMS AND FROM 8 AND 9 TEAMS (TEAMS THAT TOOK THE THIRD PLACES IN GROUPS B AND C, ONE TEAM HAS THE BEST PERFORMANCE.

WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF 11-16 TEAMS, 1-8 TEAMS REACH THE $\frac{1}{4}$ FINALS.

IN THE $\frac{1}{4}$ FINAL, TEAMS FROM THE SAME GROUP CANNOT PLAY.

DURING THE DRAW, TWO-THIRDS OF THE TEAMS CHOOSE A PAIR OF THREE TEAMS THAT TOOK THE FIRST PLACES.

THE REMAINING TEAM, WHICH WON FIRST PLACE, CHOOSES A PAIR OF TEAMS THAT TOOK SECOND PLACES.

WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF 12-16 TEAMS (4 GROUPS OF 3 TEAMS), THE FIRST TEAMS MEET WITH THE TEAMS THAT TOOK SECOND PLACES.

IN THE SEMIFINALS ARE ALSO BLIND LOT.

THE FINAL.

THE DRAW IN THE GROUPS IS CARRIED OUT ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEME:

12. BASIC TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The Games Organizing Committee provides the following technical support:

The halls for the game in accordance with paragraph 2 of these Regulations and Futsal Rules, including all the necessary material and technical equipment, including marking on the floor (temporary marking is possible).

A special requirement for a hall with stands: in view of the fact that futsal and microfozal games will be held simultaneously in this hall, it is necessary to install a barrier grid to divide the hall.

The total number of gates: 4 gates for futsal for 2 sites, 2 gates for microfutsal hall for 1 site.

12.2. Changing rooms for teams separate male and female, equipped with shower and toilet.

12.3. Judges: 4 field referees and 2 timekeepers.

12.4. 2 translators from Chinese into Russian and English.

12.5. 2 cleaning technicians also for other physical assistance.

12.6. Drinking non-carbonated water in plastic bottles of 1000 l.

12.7. Flags of the participating countries on flagpole.

13. Compliance with the Rules

The tournament is held in accordance with the Regulations on the Games, these Regulations, the Rules of the Game of Futsal and Mikrofutsal version 2018.

14. Management

The tournament is managed by the Organizing Committee of the Games, the International Futsal Federation and Mikrofutsal, the Chief Judge of the Futsal Tournament.

15. Registration fee.

The General Provisions of the Games establishes no registration fee for the futsal and microfutsal teams.

16. Financing

Financing of the Tournament is carried out by the Organizing Committee of the Games.

17. Awards

Cups and medals for 1, 2 and two 3 places for futsal, men and women, and microbutsal are also men and women. Total 4 first places, 4 second, 8 third. 10 personal prizes to the best players in special nominations. Certificates (diplomas) to participants of the competition: to all registered players and team members.

18. Final Provisions

These Regulations are approved by the Organizing Committee of the Games BRWAG 2019. The Organizing Committee of the Games in collaboration with FIFUSA has the right to make changes and additions to these Regulations, which must be promptly notified to all participants of the Games on the official website of the Games icasworld.org.
